This will be the designated DTRT Coordinator (as specified on the DTRT Coordinator Registration Form) whose **SCHOOL NOMINATED THE MOST TOP 10 STUDENT WINNERS OVERALL** throughout the nine-month school year. The Coordinator of the Year will be recognized and rewarded at the Do The Right Thing Summer Salute, a special awards dinner in June.

Do The Right Thing Nominator of the Year

We will select and announce the Do The Right Thing Nominator of the Year. This will be the teacher, counselor, school representative, or other who **PERSONALLY NOMINATED THE MOST TOP 10 STUDENT WINNERS** throughout the nine-month school year. The Nominator of the Year will be recognized and rewarded at the Do The Right Thing Summer Salute, a special awards dinner in June.

Do The Right Thing Nominator of the Month

The teacher, counselor, school representative, or other whose **NOMINATION PRODUCES THE TOP "SPECIAL RECOGNITION" STUDENT WINNERS** of the month will receive a special reward at the DTRT monthly awards ceremony. The "Special Recognition" student winner in the elementary category receives a trip to Rapids Water Park. The "Special Recognition" student winner in the middle or high school category receives a trip to Washington, D.C.
